## How to Get to Long Point



There are many ways to get to Long Point and Bird Studies Canada Headquarters from Toronto/Hamilton or London. The easiest are described here.

Coming from Toronto, take the 403 through Hamilton and Brantford to Highway 24 (Rest Acres Rd.). Take Highway 24 south through Simcoe. South of Simcoe, Highway 24 turns west. Follow it to the stop sign at Highway 59. Turn south (left) and drive until you see the flashing yellow light at Front Rd./Lakeshore Rd. Turn left and drive 400 meters to the BSC headquarters on the right.

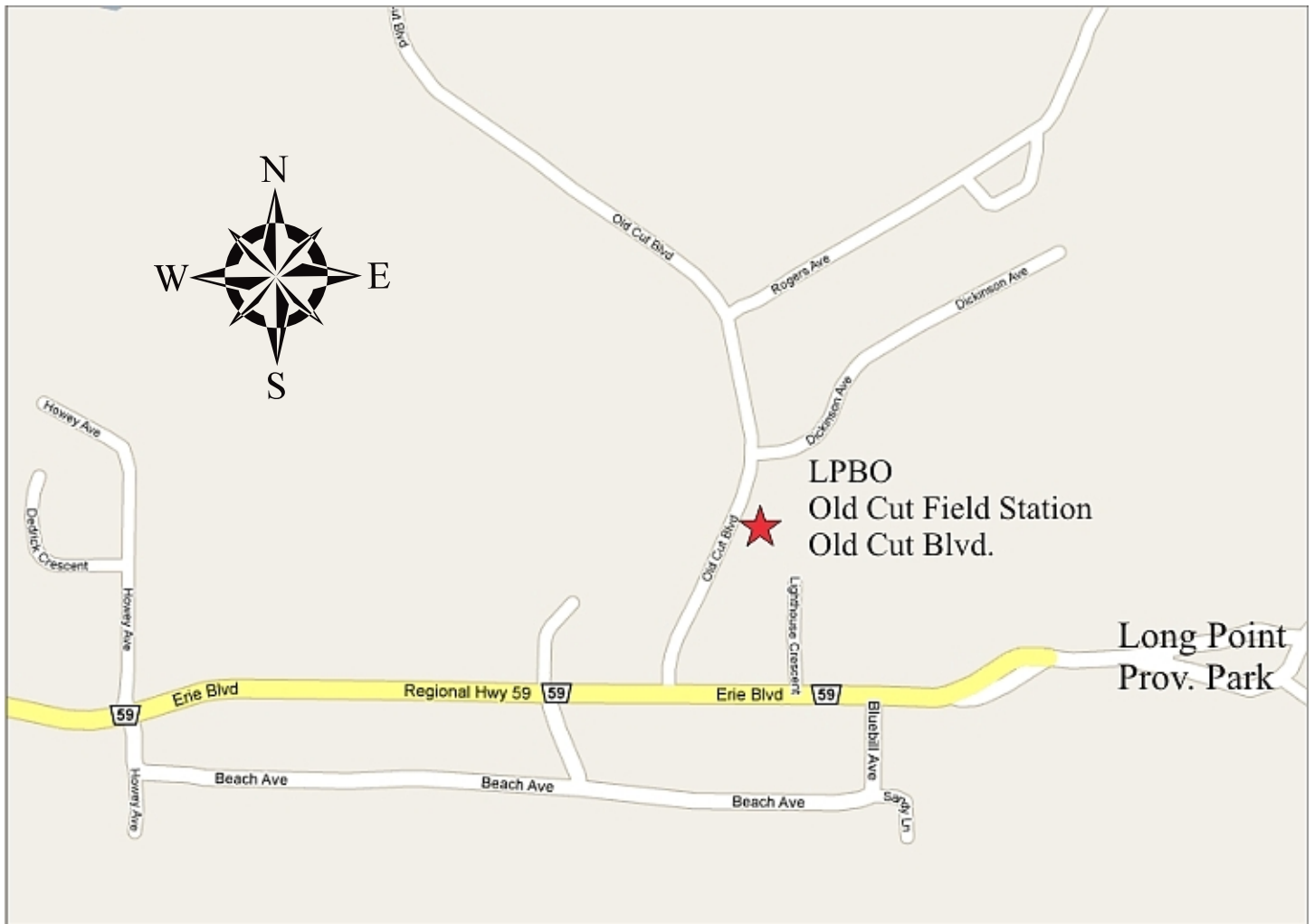
Coming from London on the 401, take Highway 19 south through Tillsonburg to Highway 3. Turn east (left) on Highway 3 and take it to Highway 59. Turn south (right) on Highway 59 and follow it through Langton and Walsingham. Drive south until you see the flashing yellow light at Front Rd./Lakeshore Rd. Turn left and drive 400 meters to the BSC headquarters on the right.

# BSC Headquarters & Port Rowan Community Centre



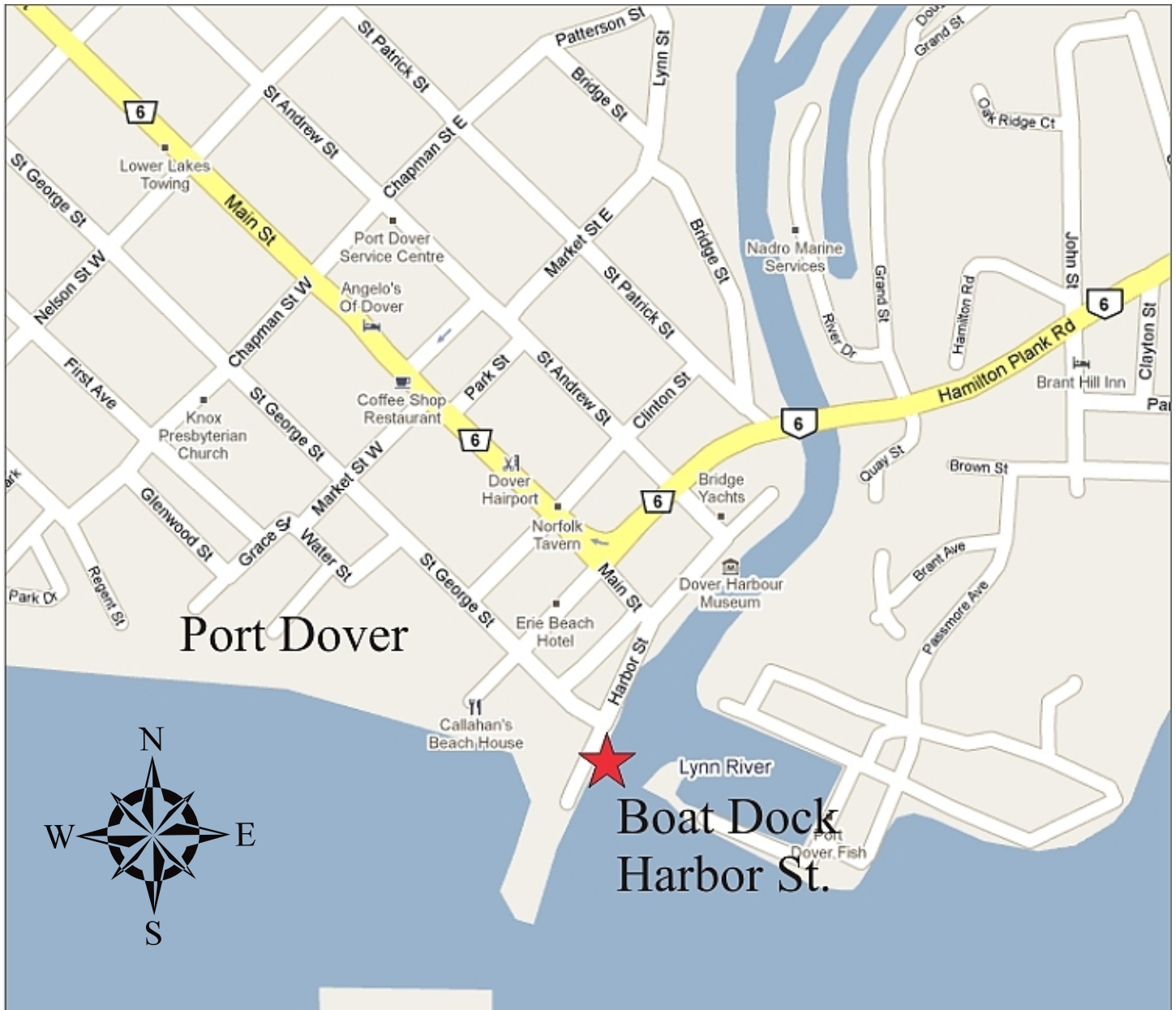
To get to the Port Rowan Community Centre, take Front Rd east (right) from the BSC Headquarters. Drive 800 meters to College Ave. (look for the funeral home on the corner). Turn north (left) and drive 100 meters to the Community Centre on the right.

# LPBO Old Cut Field Station



To get to LPBO's Old Cut Field Station from BSC Headquarters, take Front Rd. west (left) to the stop sign at Highway 59. Turn south (left) and take Highway 59 south across the causeway to Long Point. Follow Highway 59 as it turns east on Long Point and drive 3.3 kilometers to Old Cut Blvd. on the north (left) side. The field Station is the fifth house on the right (east). Look for the sign on the front lawn. Public parking is just past the entrance on the opposite side of the street.

# Port Dover Dock



To get to the departure point for Sunday's boat trip from BSCheadquarters, take Front Rd. west (left) to the stop sign at Highway 59. Turn north (right) and drive to Highway 24. Turn east (right) on Highway 24 and follow it towards Simcoe. North of the curve on Highway 24 where it turns north towards Simcoe, look for Highway 6 towards Port Dover. Turn east (right) on Highway 6 and follow it to Port Dover. Highway 6 becomes Main St. in Port Dover. Follow it straight through all of the stop lights (3) in town until it ends at the stop sign at Harbor St. Turn south (right) on Harbor St. to the dock on the left. Parking is available off St. George St. just west (right) of the dock.
